Presentation: Presenters will be responsible to submit their presentation in advance to be posted on the password-protected area of the NYSSPA website. Presenters will also need to bring their presentation on a flash drive. All meeting rooms will be equipped with a laptop, LCD projector, screen, lectern microphone and a basic internet connection.
